1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses? Please give grade level and academic area.

Due to the budget shortfalls and schools not receiving money (\$9.00 per child) from the State for library books, the library this year is unable to provide students with new library books. This grant will provide students, PreK thru 3rd grades, with fiction books, which are either requested authors or series, which a majority of the kids love, which will encourage reading. The remaining books are non-fiction and will help students in every subject area, from math to science to social studies, to language arts. Since tests scores are so important, the need for students to have up-to-date materials is also very important. If funded, this grant will provide materials to help students develop a love for reading and will help students and teachers succeed in the learning process.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

Since the Library is accessible to every student, 400 + students, all of the students at Reed (PreK thru 3rd grades) will benefit from this grant for many years.

3. Describe your grant including methods, materials and objectives. Foundation grants are intended to fund a creative teaching plan, so if equipment or materials are requested it should be clearly stated as to why these are an integral part of the plan.

This grant will provide materials on subjects which the teachers and students can use to enhance the learning experience. One way, in which the materials may be used, is to make an expert wall. Students will choose a subject from the resources provided and will find facts that they feel are important and will then do a poster or collage with information about their subject. Another way, in which, the books will be used is to make pod casts using the information from the books. In addition, to what is done in the library, these books can be used by the classroom teachers to fulfill their PASS skills requirements.

Library PASS Skills which this grant will meet:

- (i) Follow an inquiry-based process in seeking knowledge in curricular subjects, and make the real world connection for using this process in own life.
- (ii) Use prior and background knowledge as context for new learning.
- (iii) Develop and refine a range of questions to frame the search for new understanding.
- (iv) Find, evaluate, and select appropriate sources to answer questions.
- (v) Evaluate information found in selected sources on the basis of accuracy, validity, appropriateness for needs, importance, and social and cultural context.
- (vi) Read, view, and listen for information presented in any format (e.g., textual, visual, media, digital) in order to make inferences and gather meaning.
- (vii) Make sense of information gathered from diverse sources by identifying misconceptions, main and supporting ideas, conflicting information, and point of view or bias.
- (i) Display initiative and engagement by posing questions and investigating the answers beyond the collection of superficial facts.
- (ii) Demonstrate creativity by using multiple resources and formats.
- (iii) Maintain a critical stance by questioning the validity and accuracy of all information.
- (i) Continue an inquiry-based research process by applying critical-thinking skills (analysis, synthesis, evaluation, organization) to information and knowledge in order to construct new understandings, draw conclusions, and create new knowledge
- (ii) Organize knowledge so that it is useful.
- (iii) Use strategies to draw conclusions from information and apply knowledge to curricular areas, real-world situations, and further investigations.
- (iv) Collaborate with others to exchange ideas, develop new understandings, make decisions, and solve problems.
- (v) Use the writing process, media and visual literacy, and technology skills to create products that express new understandings.
