1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses? Please give grade level and academic area.

Our major educational need is to provide a high quality of sound for our students, faculty, and the community of Holdenville. This grant will affect every participant and audience member that attends a presentations, concert, assembly or academic event held at Ethel M. Reed Elementary. We are presently borrowing equipment from a community member. This is an inconvenience because the equipment is not always available. Our current sound system does not work properly. We have tried to get it repaired several times, but to our frustration it continues to break down. It is very embarrassing to continually have this happen with outside guest speakers. Not to mention the countless community members attending our events. We are concerned about the feedback we regularly receive from audience members unable to hear the speaker in the back of the cafeteria. We now have a couple of students that require special equipment for them to hear. Our current sound system does not allow them to be fully engaged during assemblies. Enjoyment of these improvements will be for all of our community and students.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

There are 430 students enrolled at Ethel M. Reed Elementary, 50 staff members and endless community members that will utilize this project throughout each year. To give you an idea here is a list of events that occur throughout the school calendar.

We have our "Fabulous Friday" Assembly the first Friday of every month with 430 students attending and around 150 parents and community members at each assembly. This occurs 10 times a year.

Teacher meetings with 50 staff members in attendance.

There are Academic assemblies such as Testing Pep Rally and Parent Nights during the school year with approximately 200-300 student, parents and family members present.

Special events occur randomly throughout the year such as Drug Free Prevention assembly, Fall Festival, PEC assembly, several motivational speakers, individual class functions and many other activities involving our entire 430 student body and immeasurable community members.

There are 5 Awards Assemblies held at the end of the year with 430 students and at least 900 family members in attendance.

I believe there will be more events in the future that Ethel M. Reed Elementary and the Holdenville Public School System will want to be recognized as having a high quality atmosphere.
