

1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses? Please give grade level and academic area.

As schools today focus on Reading and Math in the major part of the curriculum it seems that The Arts take a back seat. The Arts provide many building blocks of child development. The major educational need this grant addresses is to supply our art program with supplies for the 2017-2018 school-year, for grades Pre-K through the third grade.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

As the only Art teacher at Reed Elementary, I teach every child at Reed. Therefore, every student will be affected by this project.

3. Describe your grant including methods, materials and objectives. Foundation grants are intended to fund a creative teaching plan, so if equipment or materials are requested it should be clearly stated as to why these are an integral part of the plan.

This Grant will allow for child development, creativity, and to enrich each child's visual aesthetics in art.

Art will benefit the child's motor skills, by learning the proper way to hold a brush for the younger students as well teaching brush strokes for the older students here at

Art also involves Language development. Students will learn vocabulary that is descriptive in not only art but also in Math and Reading and other subjects. It allows students to be expressive in feelings.

Problem-solving and Critical-thinking are also strengthened in Art Education and are Decision Making skills that are taught throughout Art.

Visual Learning is taught and through drawing, painting and threading and sculpting with clay.

Inventiveness is taught and encourages children to takes risks when creating an art piece. Inventiveness in art is a way to encourage the process of thinking.

Our world is an increasingly diverse society, students must be taught about cultural awareness. The images of different groups of people in the media will help children to recognize the choices an artist makes in portraying a subject.

Studies have shown that there is a correlation between art and other subject achievement and that students who participate are more likely to be recognized for academic achievement or choose to participate in Math or Science Fair activities and to win.

This Grant will provide needed Art supplies for all students of Reed Elementary. The methods in which these supplies will be used are painting, gluing, and drawing some simple creative activities for the younger classes and increase in skill as taught in the upper grades of Reed Elementary. Some of the materials include, paint brushes, a drying rack color scratch paper, wiggly eyes, colored craft feathers, assorted large and small craft sticks, colored tissue papers with the remainder of items listed on the attached list of supplies.

The time schedule for the supplies will be August of 2017 to begin the new school year.

The Priority Academic Student Skills (PASS) will be used to measure the objectives and will be determined by the academic level of students upon completion of each project.

The success of the grant will be shown in the growth of the student's abilities to perform and grow in the areas of coloring, drawing, and painting. The students works will be on display in the buildings of Ethel Reed Elementary as well as entering different contests throughout the year.
