- 1. This grant will address needs for all grade levels. It will enhance the student support and counselor educational needs as well as testing needs.
- 2. The students that could be affected by this program could be more than 500 students during a school year.
- 3. First, the devices that will be purchased with these grant monies will enable the counselor or district testing coordinator to test students at each building. The devices will be able to be transported from site to site to test a small group of students at a time for tests such as the "Wida" for English Language Learners and the OSTP-OCCT testing that is required by federal standards. This will be utilized for grades kindergarten thru 12th grade. Next, this grant will allow the high school counselor to provide devices for a small group of students to register for the ACT test, college scholarships, FAFSA (federal financial aid) and college admissions. This will assist students in grade 9-12. Finally, these devices can be used to facilitate the new student ICAP (Individual Career Plan) that schools are now tasked to complete. This will assist students in grades 8-12.
- 4. This program can begin during the summer months but can be used throughout the school year as well.
