1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses? Please give grade level and academic area.

I am the new music and art teacher at Ethel Reed Elementary. Unfortunately, we lost every single art item, art supply, and almost all music equipment and books that we had at the school at the beginning of this year. All I had for art this year was crayons and colored pencils that I purchased for my class. It is not possible to replace all the music and art supplies and equipment that was lost. The major educational need this grant addresses is to supply our art program with supplies for the 2020-2021 school year, for Pre-Kindergarten through third grade. There is one music item set requested for the year for Pre-Kindergarten through third grade.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

As the Art and Music teacher, I teach every student at Ethel Reed Elementary, approximately 370 students.

3. Describe your grant including methods, materials and objectives. Foundation grants are intended to fund a creative teaching plan, so if equipment or materials are requested it should be clearly stated as to why these are an integral part of the plan.

This grant will allow for child development, creativity, and to enrich each child's visual aesthetics in art. Art will benefit the child's motor skills, by learning the proper way to hold a paint brush as well as teaching brush strokes along with using the correct supplies to begin painting and drawing projects.

Art also involves Language development. Students will learn vocabulary that is descriptive in not only art, but also in Math, Reading and other subjects. It allows students to be expressive in feelings. Problem-solving and critical-thinking are also strengthened in Art Education, as are decision making skills that are taught throughout art. Visual learning is taught through drawing, painting and sculpting with clay.

Inventiveness is taught and encourages children to take risks when creating an art piece. Inventiveness in art is a way to encourage the process of thinking. Our world is an increasingly diverse society, students must be taught about cultural awareness. The images of different groups of people in the media will help children to recognize the choices an artist makes in portraying a subject. Studies have shown that there is a correlation between art and other subject achievement and that students who participate are more likely to be recognized for academic achievement or choose to participate in Math or Science Fair activities.

This Grant will provide needed art supplies for my students in Ethel Reed Elementary. The methods in which these supplies will be used are painting and drawing some simple creative activities. A complete list of the requested art and music items and materials are attached to this application.

The item set requested for music will allow the students to learn, hear, and practice beat, sound, rhythm, and movement to music.

In music, the success of the grant will be shown in growth in the student's abilities to grow and perform in the areas of music, beat, rhythm, and movement.
