1. What is the major educational need this grant addresses?

This grant will be used to educate students in grades 8-12. It addresses the standard of generating and conceptualizing artistic ideas and work. Students will investigate multiple perspectives and solutions to staging challenges in a drama/theater work and imagine and explore solutions to design challenges in a drama/theater work.

2. Approximately how many pupils will be affected by this project, both directly and indirectly?

Students directly affected would number approximately 15-20 in the drama class. Students indirectly affected would be the student body of approximately 300 who would see productions using the staging blocks.

3. Describe your grant including methods, materials and objectives. Foundation grants are intended to fund a creative teaching plan, so if equipment or materials are requested it should be clearly stated as to why these are an integral part of the plan.

This grant would purchase nine staging blocks that would allow for multiple levels to be created on the flat stage which can also double as furniture and other set pieces limited only by the directors' and actors' imaginations.

4. Give a time schedule of implementation.

Once construction of these blocks are completed they would be immediately placed into use.

5. Detail your budget request. Include specific information about kinds of materials and equipment needed, sources of supply, and costs (including shipping and handling). If possible, list alternatives if full funding is not available.

The budget request is for nine (9) staging blocks in various sizes: 4 - 18x18x18, 2 - 36x18x18, 2 - 54x18x18, and 1 36x18x18. Each block will be covered in carpet on all sides but the bottoms. The blocks will be picked up from the vendor when they are completed. The total amount of the budget is \$2,475.00 - half to be paid down and half upon completion. (A copy of an estimate is attached.)

6. What methods will be used for measuring the stated objectives, or what definite evaluation will you make to determine whether the grant was successful?

The grant will be determined to be successful when the actors and stage hands gain experience creating different environments on the stage through use of these staging blocks in rehearsals and in mainstage productions.
